Move Updates:

- o Completed over the weekend for the younger grades
- A lot of parents and teachers volunteered to move the classrooms over the long weekend
- There are minor issues that need to be fixed, but this will be completed over the summer
- Upper Grades:
 - Classroom work is underway
 - Teachers will be able to get into the classrooms early to do decorations and bulletin boards.
 - Move will take place first day of spring break
 - Should not require as many volunteers

Blacktop:

- Smaller version is being put together
- It is drying out and they will be able to put temporary asphalt soon.
- Permanent blacktop will be completed over the summer
- New irrigation system and fields will also be completed over the summer.

• 3rd Grade Substitute:

- Had conversations with the children that became inappropriate for the student age and classroom setting—talking about the school shootings
- Some children were upset after the school day
- o Emails were sent by parents to inform M. Bibbee
- Substitute was removed
- o When there are concerns about substitutes they can be blocked via a form
 - Requires a declarative statement
 - HR is then contacted
 - This information is not shared with other schools (due to equal opportunity laws)

- There is discussion about how to avoid these situations in the future
- Thank you to the parents who reported this issue for doing it responsibly, directly to M.
 Bibbee (not via social media) and having confidence that this would be handled by the administration.
- Question: What is the estimated finish date?
 - \circ July 1st inside of the school done / Aug 15th all tasks complete
 - o There may still be work to blacktop, trailer removal, etc. after this date
- Custodians have been so helpful during this move
 - o If the PTA wanted to recognize these individuals it would be very deserved.
 - o The PTA will make sure to recognize them during Teacher Appreciation Week.
- Question: Drainage at the end of the planter, there is a drainage line that goes straight into the Kiss and Ride line
 - This was not built according to design
 - o There is concrete under the planter
 - The drainage was an afterthought and it is being looked at but there is not an official plan.
